



## TOEFL iBT

(Test of English as a Foreign Language - Internet Based Test)

The test requires the student to use all the skills together - for example, speaking in response to listening or reading, writing in response to listening. Rather than focusing on skills in isolation, the student will develop all the skills simultaneously, exercising their overall ability to communicate in English.

The new test, iBT (internet-based TOEFL), assesses the student's ability to function in an English-language college and university. They've eliminated the grammar section, and placed a new emphasis on communication.

TOEFL iBT Preparation Program was developed for this single purpose: to give students the guidance and practice they need to put all their English skills together. Students will learn test-taking strategies, communicate in complex, meaningful ways, and develop the confidence they need to meet their full potential.

### Course Details

- \* **Listening Comprehension** - Develops the student's ability to understand spoken English and familiarizes the student with the type of listening exercises on the TOEFL iBT.
- \* **Written Expression** - Allows the student to improve his/her written fluency and accuracy on any topic and in response to a wide variety of material.
- \* **Vocabulary and Reading Comprehension** - Develops the student's ability to understand written English with a focus on vocabulary expansion and reading strategies.
- \* **Spoken Expression** - Helps the student develop his/her ability to speak about any given topic in correct and meaningful English.
- \* **Test Strategy** - Review of various test strategies along with practice exercises will help the student succeed on the TOEFL.
- \* **Skills Integration** - The iBT test requires that students use all of their skills together - for example, speaking in response to listening or reading, writing in response to listening.

## TOEIC

(Test of English for International Communication)

### The TOEIC® test measures proficiency in international business English

- TOEIC® test is the most widely used English language test for professional English.

### The format of the TOEIC® test

Based on real-life work settings, the TOEIC® test consists of 200 multiple-choice questions categorised into listening comprehension and reading sections.

TOEIC® test questions are based on real-life work settings in an international environment (meetings, travel, telephone conversations, etc). The TOEIC® test is a paper and pencil test consisting of 200 multiple-choice questions, divided into 2 separately timed sections. Test takers respond to questions by marking one response from a choice of 4 (A, B, C, D) with a pencil on a machine-scannable answer sheet.

### Section 1: Listening Comprehension

- A variety of recorded statements, questions, and short conversations in English.
- You will answer 100 questions based on what you hear.
- You will have 45 minutes to complete this section.

This section comprises 4 parts:

Part 1: photographs (20 questions)

Part 2: question-response (30 questions)

Part 3: Short conversations (30 questions)

Part 4: Short talks (20 questions)

- A variety of materials to be read.
- You will respond to 100 questions based on what you have read.
- This section will take 75 minutes to complete.

## **IELTS - General** (International English Language Testing System)

IELTS is the International English Language Testing System. It measures ability to communicate in English across all four language skills - listening, reading, writing and speaking - for people who intend to study or work where English is the language of communication.

The **General Training** Reading and Writing Modules are not designed to test the full range of formal language skills required for academic purposes, but emphasize basic survival skills in a broad social and educational context. General Training is suitable for candidates who are going to English speaking countries to complete their secondary education, to undertake work experience or training programmes not at degree level, or for immigration purposes to Australia, Canada and New Zealand.

### **Test Format**

General Training Reading - 3 sections  
General Training Writing - 2 tasks  
Listening - 4 sections  
Speaking - 14 minutes  
**Total Test Time:** 2 hours 45 minutes

All candidates must complete four Modules - Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking to obtain an IELTS Test Report Form. Candidates are tested in Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking. All candidates take the same Listening and Speaking Modules. There is a choice between Academic and General Training in the Reading and Writing Modules. The first three modules - Listening, Reading and Writing - must be completed in one day. The Speaking Module may be taken, at the discretion of the test centre, in the period seven days before or after the other Modules. The tests are designed to cover the full range of ability from non-user to expert user.

## IELTS - Academic (International English Language Testing System)

IELTS is the International English Language Testing System. It measures ability to communicate in English across all four language skills - listening, reading, writing and speaking - for people who intend to study or work where English is the language of communication.

The **Academic** Reading and Writing Modules assess whether a candidate is ready to study or train in the medium of English at an undergraduate or postgraduate level. Admission to undergraduate and postgraduate courses is based on the results of these Modules.

### Test Format

General Training Reading - 3 sections

General Training Writing - 2 tasks

Listening - 4 sections

Speaking - 14 minutes

**Total Test Time:** 2 hours 45 minutes

All candidates must complete four Modules - Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking to obtain an IELTS Test Report Form. Candidates are tested in Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking. All candidates take the same Listening and Speaking Modules. There is a choice between Academic and General Training in the Reading and Writing Modules. The first three modules - Listening, Reading and Writing - must be completed in one day. The Speaking Module may be taken, at the discretion of the test centre, in the period seven days before or after the other Modules.
